  - Phase II <u>Comprehensive measures needed to eradicate Chronic</u> <u>Wasting Disease in Norway</u>
- <u>Assessment of the risks associated with the import and release of</u> <u>hand-reared mallards for hunting purposes</u>
- <u>Assessment of risks to animal health and biodiversity from import</u> and farming of Australian red claw crayfish
- <u>Microorganisms in biostimulants</u>
- Assessment of risk for introduction of infectious diseases from increasing wild boar population affecting Norwegian fauna and pork production
